

2020 Band Fee: \$550

The actual cost per student to participate in the North Green Brigade marching band is approximately \$1300.

Here is a short list of expenses that are paid in part by band fees:

1. Bus transportation for nine contests including two trips to Indianapolis for ISSMA competition.
2. Hotel accommodations for the overnight stay in Indianapolis the weekend of ISSMA State Finals.
3. A highly experienced instructional staff that teaches our students to achieve at a State Finals level of performance.
4. A design team that creates a production that not only meets that specific educational level of our students but is also highly competitive at the state level.
5. Custom uniforms, costumes and flags.
6. Show shirts.
7. Food for 32 full meals and 18 meals/snacks.

Therefore, it is crucial that band fees are paid AND every family participates in the fundraising efforts to meet the financial needs of the band.

The band also relies on the generosity of many people for donations (all tax deductible). We have started a NEEDS list for 2020 to decrease our costs. If you can assist in acquiring any of these items, please reach out to the Band Booster president or one of the Band Directors.
