- Chaperones – Bus chaperones to & from competitions
- Chuck Wagon – numerous adults needed to help prepare food, hauling coolers and feeding students during band camp and throughout competition season.
- Fundraising – assists with organizing, administering and overseeing all approved fundraising activities for student accounts and the overall greater good of the organization
- Pit Crew/Prop Crew – help transport props on/off trucks and performance field at contests, help with prop construction and maintenance
